The ENVIROMED project's website is openly accessible at https://www.enviromed.eu/ and is managed by METIS BALTIC. The current iteration has been created to accommodate the requirements of the ENVIROMED project and its consortium, as well as to address suggestions and feedback from the initial review process. Specifically, the present version employs a modern template to accurately represent the consortium's intentions and to captivate diverse audiences, particularly the general public and crucial stakeholders.

The foremost goals of the ENVIROMED website include:

- a. Creating an online presence and sharing generated information and materials with the public;
- b. Increasing awareness of ENVIROMED and supplying updates to all stakeholders regarding the project's progress.

The technical aspects, organizational layout, and primary features of the website are outlined in the subsequent sections, accompanied by brief explanations of each web page.

2.1 Technical Infrastructure

The website is hosted on a high-performance server, leased by partner Metis Baltic, with reliable uptime and fast loading speeds to provide users with a seamless browsing experience. To ensure data security and privacy, the website is protected with SSL encryption to prevent unauthorized access and protect against cyber threats.

Accessibility is a key priority for the website, and it has been developed to meet the latest WCAG 2.1 AA standards. The website is optimized for all devices and screen sizes, and features user-friendly design and navigation to ensure that all users, regardless of their abilities, can easily access and use the site.

The website has been developed using WordPress, a popular and versatile content management system (CMS). WordPress was chosen for its flexibility, ease of use, and wide range of customization options. The CMS allows for efficient content creation, editing, and management, enabling the project team to easily update and maintain the website's content. 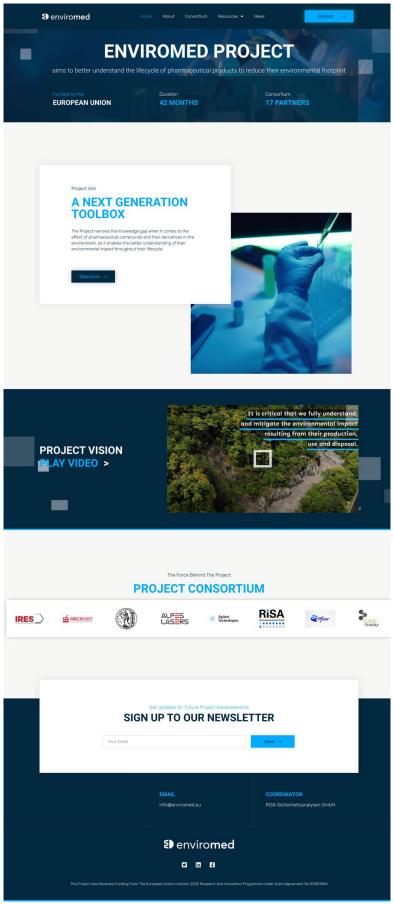


Figure 1: Home Page

On the "Consortium" page, all partners within the consortium are presented, along with their logos and links to their respective webpages.

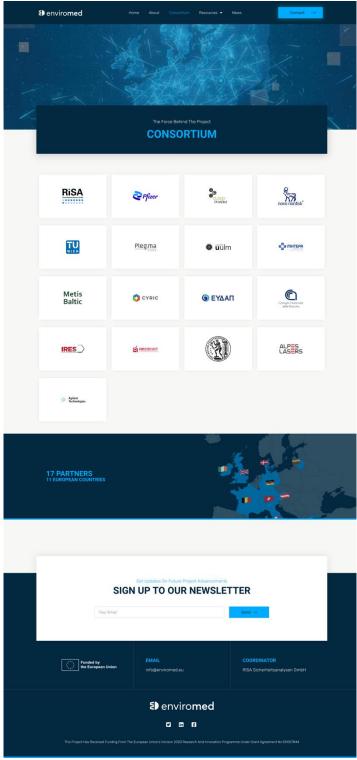


Figure 3: Consortium

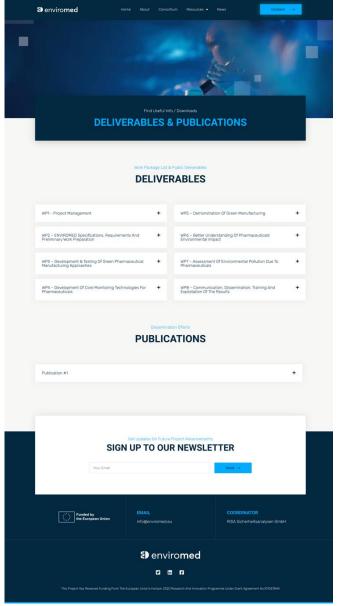


Figure 4: Deliverables & Publications

The section contains all publicly available material utilized for communication and dissemination, including the Project Brand Book and Project Logo package.

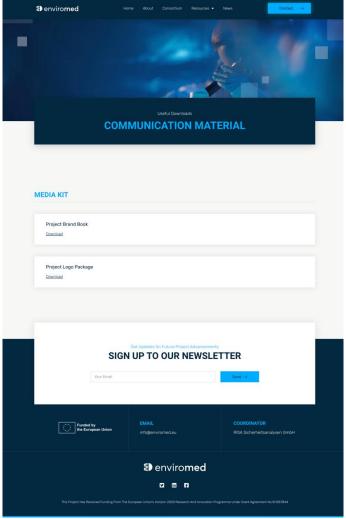


Figure 5: Communication Material

Within this section, the project media - primarily consisting of photos and videos - that have been created or utilized in the context of the project's communication activities are included.

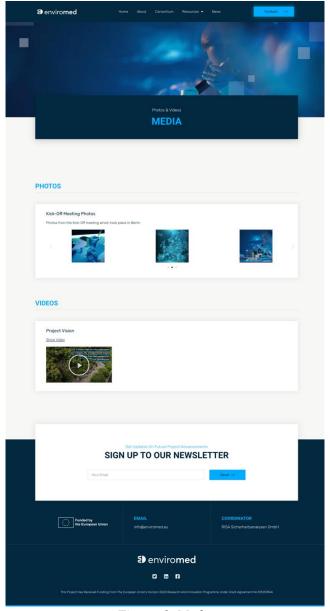


Figure 6: Media

In this section, news related to the project or other information relevant to the project's scope and objectives are presented. The news section will also highlight major milestones achieved throughout the project.

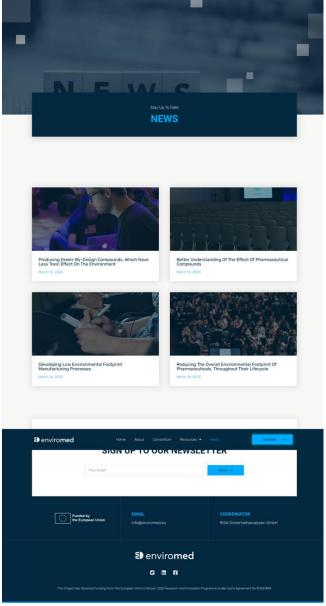


Figure 7: News page

This page provides a form for contacting the project and displays the contact details of the project coordinator.

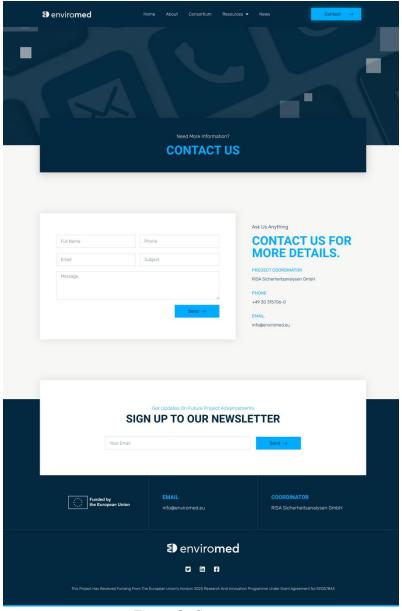


Figure 8: Contact page
